

## Maths



All 4 operations will again be covered, with a focus on multiplication and division. We will continue to develop mental and written methods including solving word problems.

Times tables will continue to be a focus. Please support your child with this learning.

In other areas we will learn, fractions and decimals and percentages.

## Science

In science we will be developing our understanding of electricity and controlling its flow in a circuit.

Later in the term, we will be learning about how light travels, how shadows are formed and about reflection and refraction.

Scientific investigations will underpin all our science work this term.
