All 4 operations will again be covered, with a focus on multiplication and division. We will continue to develop mental and written methods including solving word problems.

Times tables will continue to be a focus. Please support your child with this learning.

We will also learn about properties of shapes and angles in addition to further work on fractions and decimals.

In science we will be learning about how light travels, how shadows are formed and about reflection and refraction.

Later in the term, we will be developing our understanding of electricity and controlling its flow in a circuit.

Scientific investigations will underpin all our science work this term.
