

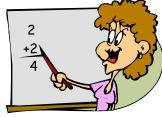

# Year 3 Autumn Term

## Maths



Our term will begin with an exploration of place value and number patterns.

We will investigate addition, subtraction, multiplication and division strategies.

We will develop our understanding of fractions and statistics, including interpreting and presenting data. Our work on shape will include investigating the features of 2D shapes and describing their properties.

To support our mental maths, we will continue with number facts and our times tables.

## English



We will be exploring and identifying the features of fables, looking at story structure, morals, and the different personalities of the characters.

We will then move on to a book study, which we will be revealed soon.

Linking to our Titanic project, we will be developing our non-fiction writing skills.

The children will be working to achieve their personal writing targets relating to presentation and composition throughout the term.

Linking to our English writing, we will be looking at the story of the Titanic, life at that time and life on board the ship.

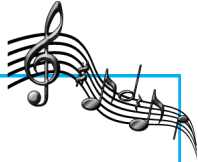
### Swimming sessions:

## Art



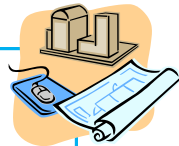
### Collage

We will create a class charter where everyone can feel supported in their learning and show consideration for others. We'll move on to focus on feelings.

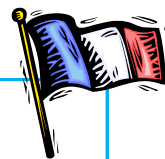
## RE



We will be investigating sacred places and places of worship, including a visit to St. Barnabus Church.

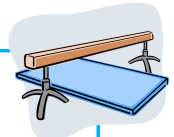
Our other topic will be exploring 'What is the Trinity?'
