

Multiplication Match

A game for two - four players

You will need a set of cards containing the table facts that you wish the students to practise. [See BLM, p. 84 for a set of tables in card format.]

Each player is dealt three cards, face down which are left on the table. The first player turns any two of the cards over, stating the product. The player must then guess whether the product on the third (unseen) card will be less than, greater than or in between the two products that have already been stated.

If the player is correct he receives a point. The used cards are not returned to the deck. Three new cards are dealt to the player. Play continues until the deck is exhausted. Shuffle and repeat for a new game.
