Y3 VISIT TO PORTSMOUTH HISTORIC DOCKYARD - WEDNESDAY, 9th JUNE

Our topic work this term includes a study of life in Tudor times and we plan to visit Portsmouth Historic Dockyard on Wednesday, 9th June. This year we will not be seeing the Mary Rose due to ongoing renovations to the hall. We will be taking part in some new and exciting activities designed to explore Tudor life through the interpretation of artefacts, thus enabling the children to develop a much fuller understanding.
