a somewhat staggering amount and all thanks to some hard work and the FANTASTIC support that we have received from you all.

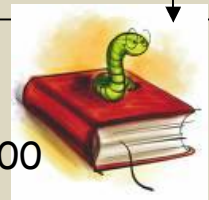
