Year 5 Only - Visit to Sir Harold Hillier Gardens and Arboretum on Thursday, 25th September

Our topic work this term includes a study of trees and how they are adapted to their environment. We plan to visit the Sir Harold Hillier Gardens and Arboretum on the above date to support this work. The day will be led by Education Officers who will share with us their expert knowledge and lead the children in some investigational activities around the gardens.
