Dear Parents

Our topic this term includes a study of water, with emphasis on rivers. We plan to walk along the Hartford Stream from the source to its lower reaches. The children will discover the human impact upon the stream and see geographical features that they are learning about in class.

As part of our classroom work we shall be making the children aware of the need to respect the stream environment and to behave safely whilst near the water. We feel this visit will enhance their geographical study and provide a memorable learning experience.

The date for the visit is Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> October and the cost of the visit is £13.00 per child. Please note this visit is non-profit making. The charge includes coach travel to Beaulieu and £4.85 for the use of the Out of Town Centre and their staff. We shall leave school at 9.10am and plan to return for the end of school at 3.30pm. Children will not need to wear school uniform and clothing needs to be suitable for the weather (no jeans please). Children will need to bring a packed lunch with a non-fizzy drink in an unbreakable container, a plastic bag to sit on, wet wipes (for wiping hands before eating), wellington boots (the path by the stream can be quite muddy after rain) and water proofs (so we are prepared for all weather conditions). These need to be carried in a backpack so that the children's hands are free at all times.
