Infant World Religion Week

It is fast approaching the time of year when the infants have a special theme week. These activities may include singing, dancing or something creative. The children carry a special card which is stamped upon completion of each activity.

The day will begin with a special sharing assembly. Each class or year group will perform a song or dance or share some of the activities from their chosen religion to the rest of the school.
