This is a list of costume suggestions for the production. It would be really helpful if you could provide costumes for other characters as well, if you have something suitable that we could borrow. We do not expect anyone to hire a costume. **Please make sure all clothes and props are clearly named.**

Character	Costume suggestion
Papa Bear, Billy Goats	Black suits, white shirts, tie
Jack Spratt	Suit trousers, shirt and tie, mackintosh, trilby hat
Police	Blue shirts and ties, black trousers (hats provided)
Goldie Lox	Blue and white gingham dress – white apron
Simple Simon	White shirt, flat cap, trousers that are slightly too short, waistcoat
Mother Hubbard, Ugly sister	Dame costumes
Mama Bear	Dress and apron
Junior Bear	Shorts and short sleeved (checked) shirt
Bo Peep, Miss Muffet	Traditional dress and bonnet
Rusty Hairclips, Dwayne Pipe	Smartly dressed – trousers, shirt and tie
Waitresses (American diner look)	Red t-shirts & skirts topped with a white apron.
Humpty Dumpty	Long socks and lederhosen style shorts with braces, large checked shirt so we can put a cushion up it.
Lumberjacks	Blue jeans/dungarees, checked shirts
Wee Willy Winky	Night cap & gown
Pip The Paperboy	Shorts, T-shirt
Doctor Foster	Surgeons outfit
Nurse Polly	Nurses outfit
The King’s men (soldiers)	Black trousers, white shirt
Three little pigs	Pink T-shirt and shorts
B B Wolf	Leather jacket, jeans, white T-shirt
Wicked Witch	Black costume
Vicar	Black trousers, black collared shirt
Scuba Diver	Wet suit, snorkel
Chef	White and blue checked trousers, white T-shirt, chef’s hat
Pirate	Tattered trousers, white shirt, waistcoat, bandana
Giant, Hansel, Peter Piper, Tom-Tom	Jeans, T-shirt
Gretel	Dress
Marigold	Black top and leggings (cow costume provided)

We would like the **bears, billy goats and ugly sister** to have some face paint applied for their role in the production. This will be for the evening performances only. Please let your child’s teacher know if your child is unable to wear face paint.

All costumes should be brought in on Wednesday 4th July ready for the pre-dress rehearsal on Monday 9th July. Please let us know if you are having difficulty finding a suitable costume as soon as possible. Thank you for your support.
