Maths

This term we will continue to develop arithmetic skills including formal written methods as well as problem solving and reasoning skills. Topics covered will include:

Fractions, decimals and percentages

Shape and Space - angles and circles

Measures: mass

Please support your children by practicing times tables and number facts.

Science

To support our topic we are visiting Winchester Science Centre to help support our work on: Earth, Sun and Moon; Seasons; Day and Year; Shadows and Phases of the moon.

We will also be looking at forces. This will include investigations such as paper spinners and floating and sinking.

English

Our work this term will include space poetry and short story writing. We will be using a variety of texts including: My Family and Other Animals by G. Durrell and Hollow Earth by J Barrowman as writing stimuli.

We will also be spending time developing Spelling,
Punctuation and Grammar knowledge and skills in preparation for the forthcoming SATS.

This term Y6 will be studying the Arctic environment and mountain environments in the UK and around the world.
