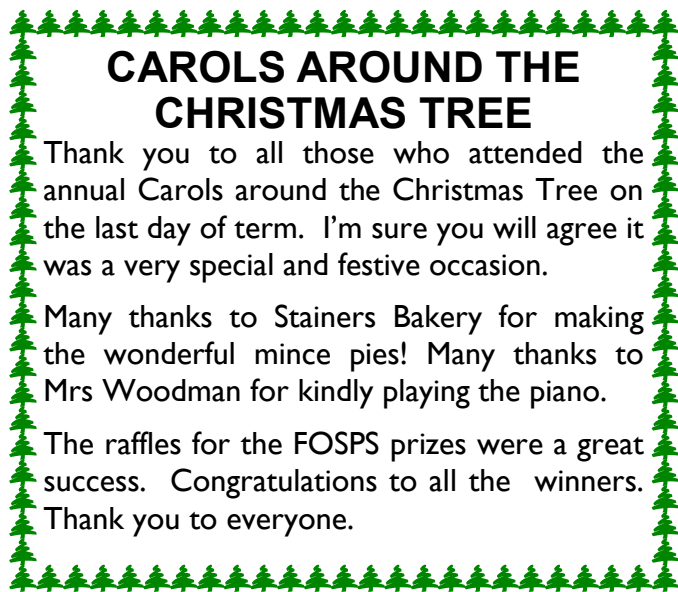




HAPPY NEW YEAR!
