## Summary of spending 2021/22

## **Objectives in spending PE & Sports Premium Grant:**

- paying for transport, pool hire and instruction to provide additional swimming lessons for those pupils unable to swim by the end of Year 6 and to all Year 3 pupils whatever their level of ability
- Support funding of play-trail
- to facilitate the hosting and organising of intra-school sporting events and interschool events with local and district schools
- to provide adequate and skill appropriate sporting equipment.
- to provide pupils access to sporting activities and life experiences inside and outside of school hours.
- to support provision of enhanced opportunities for lunches/play to support healthy lifestyles

## Nature of Support:

- Financial support for identified sporting activities
- Pyramid networking support
- Provision of sporting events
- Targeting support to increase activity for Pupil Premium PP children and those with limited access to clubs/provision
- Improved lunch opportunities
