At Swanmore CE (A) Primary School, we are keen for children to achieve in all areas of their lives and for this to happen we know that children need to be in school and on time.


Our whole school target for attendance is 96.5% for academic year 2023/2024.


Following advice from Hampshire, we will adopt the following steps in an effort to support those families where attendance and punctuality is an issue.

Parents should be aware that if the school has to enforce a Hampshire fixed penalty notice then the school does not receive the money from these penalties: all monies go to Hampshire County Council. The school has adopted this approach in response to the updated Hampshire County Council Code of Conduct June 2023.
