### **Year 2 – Visit to The Brickworks Museum**

As part of our project 'Home Sweet Home', we will be studying the houses in Swanmore and the materials from which they were made. To help us with our learning we are planning to visit The Brickworks Museum, Swanwick, to find out about the process of making bricks and how it links to our local area. This will take place on **Thursday 19th October**, and will support the children's understanding in many curriculum areas such as Geography, History and Science.

We will leave school in the morning at 9.30am and travel by coach to the Brickworks Museum and return to school around 2.45pm.

The cost of the trip is £16.75 per child. This includes entrance to the museum, tour, a workshop and transport. Although contributions to school trips are voluntary, the trip may unfortunately have to be cancelled if insufficient contributions are received.

If you would like 'Pay it Forward' and support a family who may not be able to afford the visit, please enter the amount you would like to pay, including the price for your trip. All additional donations will be used to pay for children where families are facing financial challenges.

Please may I ask you to check your eligibility for free school meals, following the link: <https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/hants> Those parents who are entitled would be eligible for assistance in meeting the cost of school trips.

If possible we would prefer payment for this trip to be paid on line via scopay and the permission slip and lunch order attached returned to the class teacher via your child. If this is not an option then please place your payment in an envelope marked with your child's name, class and "Brickworks" on the front and again return to the class teacher. We request this is all returned by **Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October** please.

Every child is entitled to have a school packed lunch. This will be made up of a cheese roll, cake, vegetable sticks and a piece of fruit.

**Please could you let the school office know to ensure the kitchen only prepares the correct number of lunches so there is no waste of food.**

Full uniform will need to be worn and sensible walking shoes. If you would prefer to provide your child with a packed lunch from home then please make sure it can be carried in a backpack so they are 'hands free'.
