## Uniform

## YR September 2024

If your child was born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020, they will be eligible to start school in the school year beginning September 2024. Applications open 1<sup>st</sup> November 2023 and the deadline is **15<sup>th</sup> January 2024** with the notification date of 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024. ## **Census Day**

It is our school census on Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> January which is where, as a school, we receive extra funding for the number of children who take up the offer of a school meal on that day. Please see attached the menu options for next Thursday.

Although families do not have to pay for school dinners until your child goes into Year 3, if you are eligible to claim free school meals, this means that your child is also eligible for pupil premium. This is additional funding the school can receive from the government, which means we can then support families with things such as subsidised school trips and other provisions within the school.

This is a fun and engaging club, where pupils will have lots of fun learning, practising and showing a mix of dance and drama skills. These sessions help pupils learn core life skills such as core strength, balance, projection of voice, presentation skills, memory and muscle coordination. Pupils will be collected from main reception at the end of the day by the dance teacher and taken across the road to the Paterson Centre, where the sessions will take place.
