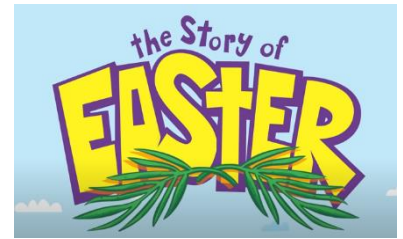


Dear Parents,

We are running a special Easter competition where we would like the children to create their own Easter garden that represents either a part, or parts of, the Easter story.

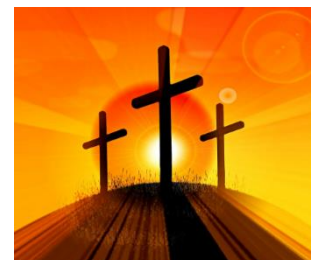
Here is the Easter story by Saddleback kids that you may want to watch together:

Here are some ideas that may help your child to create their Easter garden:



There are only two rules for our competition. Firstly, is that the three crosses must be represented in some way in the Easter garden. Next, the second rule is that the child must have created the Easter garden themselves.
